Ergonomic and lightweight, they don't get tangled up in your pocket and are hand-safe. After several decades in use, the effectiveness and reliability of this range is widely recognised in all French vineyards and abroad. The right choice for a degradable clip is one with sufficient strength at the time of installation (trellising) and very low residual strength so that it can be easily broken before pruning.

Minigraf® is recommended for trellising low vines. It can also be used to keep wires on the ground in the off-season and for trellising raspberry bushes. Minigraf is the least expensive staple on the market.
